



RESERVE REFEREE

The Reserve Referee is part of the Refereeing Corps and subject to the same Referee Code of Conduct. The Reserve Referee must report for duty at the same time as the First and Second Referee, at the start of the official match protocol or for alcohol testing if required.

The following activities form the responsibilities of the Reserve Referee:

1. To act as Second referee in any case of absence, for any reason, of one of the appointed Referees
2. To control the substitution paddles before the match and between sets
3. To check the operation of the buzzers before the match and between the sets and to liaise with the Jury if there is a problem
4. To assist the second referee in keeping the free zone and the penalty areas free
5. To assist the second referee in supervising the substitute players in the warm-up areas and on the benches
6. To give to the Second Referee two match balls, immediately after the presentation of the starting players
7. To give the Second referee a match ball after he/she has finished checking the players' positions
8. To assist the Second Referee with guiding the work of the moppers and ball retrievers.
