

15. Medical matters and anti-doping control

ParaVolley Pan Am will be participating in the World ParaVolley Injury Surveillance Program at this Championship. This will require all teams to complete a short form at the end of each match and to encourage reporting of any injuries during the match and during training while competing in this competition. Your participation in this survey can help us to determine the types of injuries in our sport for injury prevention in the future.

16. Miscellaneous and practical information

Medical care:

First aid and medical care will be provided by the organizer, except for hospital visits. Teams should arrange their own medical insurance.

Playing uniforms:

Each team must have at least 2 but preferably 3 sets of playing uniforms available. Player names must be on the shirts. Advertising on playing uniforms must comply with WPV regulations.

Teams are reminded to be familiar with and follow the World ParaVolley Sport Regulations and the Rules of the Game. Please take note specifically of the Key Differences document, in particular the uniform of the Libero and the compression garments regulations. Liberos as stated on the Final Team Entry must remain so for the entire competition.

17. Safeguarding

World ParaVolley has been implementing Safeguarding in its events. Following it, PVPA will be starting the protocol in our events.
